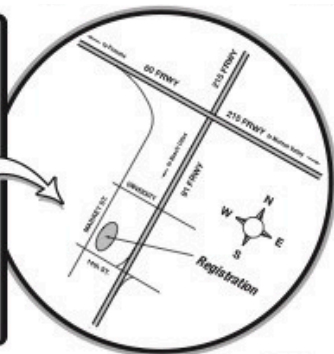
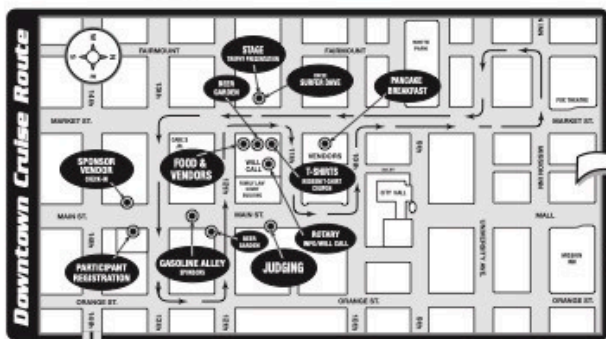

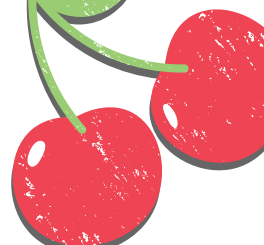
Letter from the President

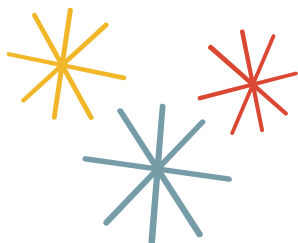

My current build Is another road race style 73 Camaro that is going to be really cool. I worked as a general contractor to help fund my car projects. My passion for cars led me to be involved with the racing world. I was a crew member on a Nitro funny car for about 10 years. We traveled all over the Western States and Canada racing. My favorite race was in Denver where the track had an agreement with the local grade schools. If the Kids read so many books the track would give them tickets to go to watch the races. I would put the kids in the car and tell them what everything did. The look on their faces was priceless I don't know who was more excited the kids or the parents. It was so cool!

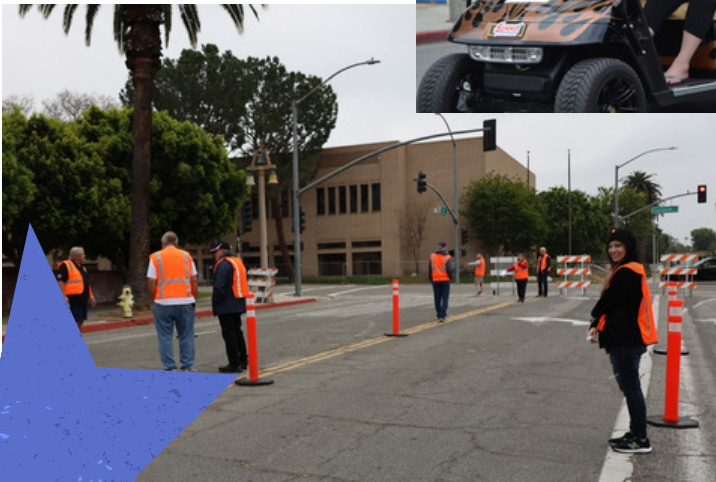


About the Old Farts Racing Team

Welcome! To all new, as well as returning members of the Old Farts Racing Team. Our sole purpose is to have old fashioned Drag Racing fun! You do not need a car to have fun; come along with someone who is participating, be a spectator, or build your own car. "Meetings" are held on the second Tuesday of every month, 6pm, at the American Legion #79 - 2979 Dexter Dr. Fairmount Park, Riverside, Ca. 92501. We have no club Officers, What we call meetings are actually probably better defined as "bullshit sessions", for lack of a better term-

The Old Farts Racing Team (OFRT) was formed in April 1993 when longtime friends Ron Speer and Dave Barnekow got together and thought "You know, we should form a group who share our interests in Hot Rods and Drag racing..." The rest is history. It began as a loose-knit association, and has grown into a pivotal consortium involved in a number of worthy causes and charities.

How the cars are judged

Each judge looks and scores only one part of the car, so when they pass by the car, they are concentrating only on that part of your car. Each judge puts a rating from 1-10 on his sheet for your car with a possible score of 60. These scores are then put into a computer and it will tell us who wins. The point spread for the Top 50 cars is usually within 15 points. We all build cars and appreciate the work and time you put into your car, but we have 3 hours to judge approximately 300 cars, so unfortunately we do not have the time to discuss your car. We thank you for bringing your car to the show and look forward to your return in the following years.

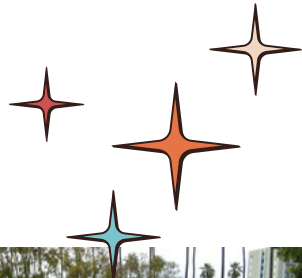

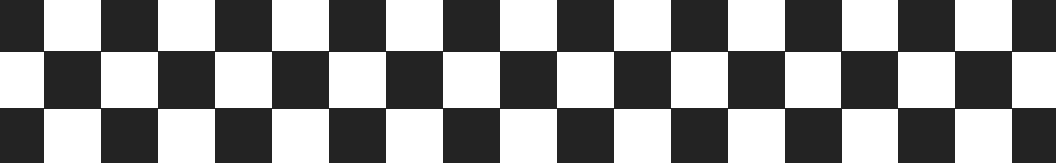

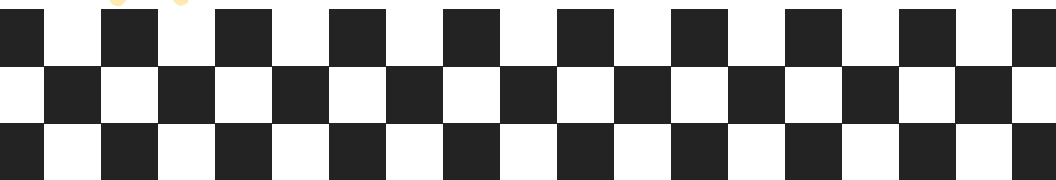
